Testing of Web - now also supported for PrimeFaces, ZK and RAP 2

Quality Assurance for web user interfaces is becoming increasingly difficult as test automation tools are able to deal with the growing complexity of AJAX tool kits only to a limited extent.

The established GUI test tool QF-Test is using its own solution and the current version 3.5.1 includes support for PrimeFaces, ZK and RAP version 2.

QF-Test reduces the complex structures implemented by tool kits to generic components. Standard elements of a GUI like trees, tables or lists will be addressed as such with the technical details abstracted away. This simplifies quality assurance for both user groups of QF-Test - developers as testers - enormously. Neither are developers required to adapt each element (cell, tree node and so on) nor do testers need to familiarize themselves with the details of each toolkit.

The well-known AJAX tool kits already supported by earlier QF-Test versions include Ext JS, Vaadin and RichFaces.
